Graduate Program Costs

- Tuition: \$375 per credit hour
- Academic Support Fee: \$60 per semester
- Site Fee: \$500 per semester

FINANCIAL AID AND COST DETAILS

- Students must complete financial registration to begin courses. A 1/3 down-payment plus your \$500 site fee for the semester is due at that time. Financial aid can be used towards that down-payment. Students are able to pay their entire bill before beginning courses via payment or financial aid, or they can use the Deferred Payment Plan.
- A student's bill must be paid in full before beginning classes for the next semester.
- SAGU allows each student to charge up to \$500 in textbooks to their student bill each semester. Students must complete financial registration before being able to use the book charge allowance. Textbooks must be ordered through the SAGU Bookstore at www.sagustore.com in order for the student to use the \$500 charge allowance.
- While students are not eligible for additional SAGU institutional aid, students are encouraged to complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov in order to use federal aid. Students should enter SAGU's School Code (003616) so information will be sent to SAGU for processing. Outside scholarships can also be applied to student balances.
